Equestrian Life Championship Rules

Competitors of the Equestrian Life Championship do not need to be affiliated or be members of any Society, unless you are entering a qualifier class on the day that requires membership. Combinations that have qualified for or competed at HOYS or RIHS in 2014 or 2015 are not eligible to enter Equestrian Life Championship Qualifier classes, they are however eligible to enter qualifiers for other classes being held on the day.

Entry to THIS show is for REGISTERED Competitors only holding a 2015 Registration Card – You May Register on the Day – Registration is £20.00. All persons entering, competing or otherwise being present at the show are subject to the rules and regulations governing Equestrian Life Shows. Owners entering animals do so entirely at their own risk, and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attaches itself to the promoters or organizers or venue in any respect whatsoever.

No age limit on classes for ponies, ALTHOUGH riders MUST be a suitable size and weight for the pony they are riding.

Judges will not ride in any classes. Spurs are not to be worn by riders 16 years and under or in M & M or Veteran classes. Spurs must not be worn in any mixed class pony championship. Spurs may only be worn by adults on horses.

Show canes/whips are not to exceed 30".

Hats to the approved current BSI standard and chin straps fastened must be worn, with the exception of the Evening Performance when bowlers and top hats may be worn, at the competitors' discretion for those who are aged 18 & Over and have signed the disclaimer on the entry form. Please note that for all Side Saddle classes, there is no compulsory hat ruling for Adult riders. A chin-strap hat must be worn by all Junior competitors.

All complaints are to be made in writing. Any complaints made via email or social media sites will be disregarded.

Any ruling not covered that arises, the decision will be at the discretion of the show organisers.

Clashing of Classes

Whilst every effort has been taken to avoid clashing of classes, this may be unavoidable. Equestrian Life reserves the right to alter/amend the schedule as they see fit. No refunds of entries will be given if competitors are entered in classes that clash. Due to the tight schedule, you will need to prioritise which class/ championship you would prefer to enter in the event of clashing

Amateur Status

Equestrian Life Qualifiers and Championships remain for the true amateur. Animals must not have been on a professional producer's/trainer's yard since 1st January in the current year. Riders are not eligible to compete any animal which has been ridden or produced by a professional producer/trainer at any show since 1st January in the current year, but they are able to compete any other animal that has not been produced or ridden professionally since the 1st of January in the current year. Animals and riders must not receive any help from a professional producer/trainer at any show including transporting animals to and from the show since 1st January in the current year. The definition of a professional producer/trainer is a person who undertakes the preparation or production of horses or ponies belonging to other exhibitors for the show ring. Animals must not be ridden at the show by a rider who has ridden for a professional producer or trainer.

Stallions

Mannerly, responsibly handled stallions are welcome to compete in our Ridden, In Hand and Working Hunter classes, however stallions and colts MUST NOT be led or ridden by any juniors who have not attained their 14th Birthday. Stallions MUST only be ridden or handled by competent people. Any stallion that constitutes a danger to its handler or to other competitors / horses, will be requested to leave the class/ venue, and will not be refunded.

This show is a qualifier for the 2015 TSR Riders/In Hand Regional Championships. Riders/Handlers can choose which Regional final they go to Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, Wales & South West or Scottish. TSR Riders Champs - 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring. TSR In Hand Champs - The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand class. TARRA

TARRA Ridden: Open to all Weatherbys (or relevant foreign thoroughbred authority) registered Thoroughbreds raced or unraced (passports may be checked) 4yrs and over owned and ridden by an amateur. Ideally racing name of horse to be used on entry form. Class will be judged under a 'riding horse' format without 'type' being taken into consideration. Injuries and blemishes caused through racing will be overlooked. The first two horses will qualify and qualification will pass down the line to fourth place only. The judge may ride. This is a qualifier for the TARRA Ridden Championship at Aintree, August 2015. TARRA In-Hand: Open to all Weatherbys (or relevant foreign thoroughbred authority) registered Thoroughbreds raced or unraced (passports may be checked) any age owned and shown by an amateur. Ideally racing name of horse to be used on entry form. Class will be judged under a normal in-hand format with injuries and blemishes caused through racing will be overlooked. The first two horses will qualify and qualification will pass down to fourth place only. This is a qualifier for the TARRA In-Hand Championship at Aintree, August 2015. TARRA Amateur definition: An individual who does not receive any remuneration from the showing, riding or production of show horses. Individuals employed in other equestrian disciplines shall be classified as amateurs for the sake of the TARRA show series. Any breaches of this ruling will be taken seriously and may result in exemption from future classes

Traditional Gypsy Cob Association

TGCA In Hand and Ridden Classes. These classes are qualifiers for the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association (TGCA) National Breed Championship Show, The Traditional of the Year Show "TOYS" 18th and 19th September 2015 at Onley Grounds EC, Warwickshire. These classes are open to all traditional gypsy cobs. You do not need to be a current member or to have your horse registered with the TGCA in order to take part in these classes. Qualification will go to the top 3 in each section, youngstock, not exceeding 142 cm and exceeding 142 cm in senior in hand and ridden classes. All exhibits must be registered (passports over - stamped) and owners and handlers be fully paid up members either prior to, or within 21 days of the show date. Existing members must present their qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature. Non members will receive a qualification card from the judge and need to join the TGCA and register their horse within the 21 day timeframe in order to validate this qualification. All stallions (four years and over) must be licensed with the TGCA prior to the show and must display their TGCA stallion disc on their bridle when competing in order to qualify for TOYS. Non licensed stallions may compete in the classes but are not eligible for qualification. All stallions and colts (two years and over) must be bitted when in the ring. Foals born in the current year are not permitted to be shown in TGCA classes, though they may be shown at TOYS. Ridden Classes: Exhibits must be 4 years and over and comply with the above. Additional TOYS qualification is awarded to the highest placed junior rider and the highest placed exhibitor eligible for the restricted category in the class (i.e. rider and exhibit NOT to have qualified for HOYS, RIHS, Olympia or been placed 1st to 3rd at county level or any TOYS Finals in the past 24 months). Cards need to be signed for the categories.

Open Ridden Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 153cms. Riders any age.

Classes may be divided as follows:

- Lightweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, capable of carrying up to 12.7 stone
- Middleweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, capable of carrying up to not more than 14 stone
- Heavyweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, capable of carrying more than 14 stone

Class 12 – Ridden Show Pony Not Exceeding 148cm, 4yrs Old & Over - ELS, RL, EF, TSR

Open Show Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 148cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Classes may be divided as follows:

- Show Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 13th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- Show pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 128cms but not exceeding 138cms. Riders not to have attained their 15th birthday before 1st January in the current year
- Show pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 138cms but not exceeding 148cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 13 – Mountain & Moorland Ridden Small Breeds – No Lead Rein – 4yrs & Over - ELS, RL, EF, TSR

Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Exmoors, Shetlands, Dartmoors and Welsh A + B. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Rider Any Age

Class 14 – Mountain & Moorland Ridden Large Breeds – 4yrs & Over ELS, RL, EF, TSR

Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C and D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Rider Any Age

Class 15 – Ridden Rare, Foreign & Heavy Breeds – 4yrs & Over No M & M's, No Irish Draught or Plaited Warmblood Types – Haflinger, Fresian, Fjords, Comtois, Akhal Teke, Arabian, Caspian, Morgan, Eriskay, Cleveland Bay ELS & RL

Class 16 – Alternative Coloured Ridden – 4yrs & Over Palominos, Cremellos, Duns, Roans, Splash Marked & Spotted ELS & RL

Class 17 – Junior Equitation Championships Qualifying Class

Run under SSA rules defined in the current Members' Handbook. Open to SSA Junior Members and Non-Members aged under 18 on 1st January of the current year. Members carrying their current Championship Points Cards are eligible for SSA rosettes to 3rd place and SSA Championship Points. Southernden Farm Offers a rosette to the highest placed Member aged under 14 on 1st January of the current year. Manor Grange Stud Show Centre offer a rosette to the Junior Member, judged to be the best turned out.

Class 18 – Adult Equitation Championships Qualifying Class

Run under SSA rules defined in the current Members' Handbook. Open to SSA Adult Members and Non-Members aged 18 or over on 1st January of the current year. Members carrying their current Championship Points Cards are eligible for SSA rosettes to 3rd place and SSA Championship Points. Side Saddle International offer a rosette to the Adult Member, judged to be the best turned out

Class 19 – Classical Ladies Side Saddle Qualifier

Open to SSA Adult Members and Non-members, aged 18 and over on January 1st of the current year, riding side saddle, on horses exceeding 148cms (14.2hh). To be judged 25% conformation and action, 25% manners & way of going, 25% rider, and 25% turnout of horse & rider, by a SHBGB, BSHA, BSPS, P(UK) or SSA Panel Judge. Judges may request a short show, but will not ride exhibits; horses will not be stripped. Traditional habits must be worn. Fancy Dress and Period Costumes NOT permitted. Judges are requested to use the mark sheet provided. The highest placed horse/rider combination qualifies for the Final to be held at the National Side Saddle Show. In the event of previous qualification, this may be passed down to fourth place. Special rosettes are offered by Mrs. T. Mitchell to the winner and if the winner has already qualified, a second rosette is awarded with the Qualification Card.

Qualifying combinations are required to become Full Members of the SSA 21 days prior to the National Side Saddle Show or as soon as possible if qualified after that date to be eligible to compete at the Final. Combinations qualifying between one National Side Saddle Show and the next may carry forward the qualification, for that year only. The highest placed Riding Horse, Hack (not exceeding 160cm), Cob or Hunter, Mare or Gelding, 4 years and over, ridden by a SSA Adult Member qualifies for The 2015 BSHA Championship Show Total Impact Equestrian Ladies Show Horse Championship and if already qualified the ticket will go to the next highest placed horse down to 5th place.

The qualification period is 1st January, 2015 to 11th September, 2015. SSA Members who qualify for The Ladies Show Horse Championship, will not be required to join the BSHA in order to compete in any Side Saddle class at the BSHA National Championship Show. If the BSHA Championship Show entries have closed at the time of qualification, competitors will not be charged a late entry fee for the Championship.

Class 20 – Best Horse or Pony Ridden Side Saddle

Open to horses and ponies 4 years old or over: conformation & manners will be taken into consideration; horses/ponies will not be stripped. A Special rosette will be awarded to the highest placed Adult and Junior Members of the SSA carrying their current Championship Points Cards

All exhibits must be registered (passports over-stamped) and owners and handlers be fully paid up members either prior to, or within 21 days of the show date.

Existing members must present their qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature.

Non-members will receive a qualification card from the judge and need to join the TGCA and register their horse within the 21 day timeframe in order to validate this qualification. All stallions (four years and over) must be licensed with the TGCA prior to the show and must display their TGCA stallion disc on their bridle when competing in order to qualify for TOYS.

Non licensed stallions may compete in the classes but are not eligible for qualification. All stallions and colts (two years and over) must be bitted when in the ring. Foals born in the current year are not permitted to be shown in TGCA classes, though they may be shown at TOYS.
